Due to State mandates we are unable to have quests at the resort with the exception of "essential employees"-doctors, nurses, lab employees, etc. - for the month of May. We have been reaching out to our owners that have been affected by Governor Mills' "Stay Safer at Home" order. We are unable at this time to give an opening date as it is in the hands of our governor. However, it appears as though lodging is part of phase 2 of our governor's reopening Maine's Economy Plan. Phase 2 is scheduled for June 1<sup>st</sup> and states that lodging may open to Maine residents or out-of-state residents who have completed the quarantine guidelines. The CDC is to release a checklist for those in phase 2 to go by in order to safely reopen. We are currently awaiting the list but in the meantime have already added protective measures throughout the resort.

- Social distancing signs
- Taped out 6 foot sections
- Plexiglass in the window at the front desk
- Hand sanitizer readily available
- High touched surfaces are disinfected multiple times throughout the day
- All amenities have been temporarily closed
- Protective gear has been ordered (masks, disinfectants, sanitizers)

During the mandated closure we have been using the time to get some work done around the resort. The ladies locker room has been completely redone, men's locker room has also had some updates, a new pool liner has been purchased and is waiting to be installed, multiple units have been painted top to bottom, a new sign in the pool area has been purchased and installed, and the treadmill in the fitness room has been repaired.

Our housekeeping team has been working tirelessly to ensure every unit on the property has been thoroughly deep cleaned before our reopening. Employees have also been steam cleaning all the carpets, furniture, and upholstery in the units.

Because our priority is the safety of our owners, guests, and employees, we may not be able to safely open early June unless we are able to obtain a sufficient supply of wipes, hand sanitizers, and disinfectant sprays. We are working hard to purchase the supplies needed to ensure a safe and clean property to come to once the travel restrictions in Maine have been lifted. Until then stay healthy & safe!
